- Eligibility: Residents of U.S. Midwest Region (IL, IN, IA, MI, MN, MO, ND, SD, WI)
- Each participant can submit a maximum of 2 photographs.
- By sending the photographs, the participant agrees that the Government of India has the right to disseminate, distribute, transfer, transform, usage on websites, usage on social media handles and use in any subsequent publicity campaigns and materials.
- All entries must include name, age, city of residence, caption for the photograph, short description (max. 75 words), email address and telephone number. The personal information is only used for the purpose of this competition and to notify the selected participants.
- The decision of the jury shall be final and binding. The selected entries will be recognized and exhibited at the Consulate premises in Chicago.
